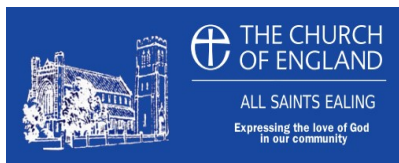

One person on behalf of both may complete this form.

Seven days' notice is required before the first reading of banns. They are read on three Sundays before the marriage.

(Section 3) If either are under the age of 18 on the day of the wedding, not widowed, the consent of parents/guardians is required.

(Sections 4,11,12) The official rules do not permit the marriage in church of anyone who has been divorced from a person still living.

(Section 6) Include town, county and postcode.

(Section 15) ie The Church of England parish in which you live.

If either of you does not live in the parish where marriage is to take place, you must arrange for banns to be read in your own parish and obtain a banns certificate.
